## VOLUNTARY SAFETY RECALL CAMPAIGN

SUBJECT: A/T FLUID COOLER HOSE REPLACEMENT (SC 129)

### \* NOTICE

This bulletin has been revised to include additional information. New/revised sections of this bulletin are indicated by a black bar in the margin area.

This bulletin provides the procedure to replace the A/T cooler hoses in certain 2011 MY Forte (TD) vehicles produced from August 27, 2010 through November 11, 2010. The automatic transmission fluid cooler hoses may have been improperly cured during the manufacturing process. This condition may result in the loss of transmission fluid. If sufficient fluid is lost, the loss of hydraulic pressure to the transaxle could result in reduced vehicle mobility. To correct this condition follow the procedure outlined in this bulletin. Before conducting the procedure, verify the vehicle is included in the list of affected VINs.



### \* NOTICE

There is no charge to the vehicle owner for this repair. Under applicable law, you may not sell or otherwise deliver any affected vehicle until it has been repaired pursuant to the procedures set forth in this bulletin.


## A/T FLUID COOLER HOSE REPLACEMENT (SC 129)

## \* NOTICE

To assure complete customer satisfaction, always remember to refer to WebDCS Warranty Coverage (validation) Inquiry Screen (Service > Warranty Coverage > Warranty Coverage Inquiry) for a list of any additional campaigns that may need to be performed on the vehicle before returning it to the customer.

### **Service Procedure:**

- 1. Turn ignition switch to the OFF position.
- 2. Record the customer's radio presets.
- 3. Disconnect the Positive (+) terminal (A) and Negative (-) terminal (B) from the battery.




4. Remove one (1) bolt securing the battery mounting bracket (C) to the chassis.




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5. Remove four (4) bolts (D) securing the battery tray to the chassis.




6. Undo the battery connector attachment point (E) on the battery tray (F), as shown.




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
7. Locate the five (5) mounting locations (G) for the harness channel.



8. Use a pick tool tool (H) to undo each mounting location, as shown.



9. Remove the final battery tray mounting location (I), as shown.



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
10. Remove the battery tray (J), as shown.



11. Disconnect the battery sensor connector (K), as shown.




12. Locate the upper (L) and lower (M) A/Tcooler hoses.




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13. Remove the upper A/T cooler hose (N).



14. Remove the lower A/T cooler hose (O).



- 15. Install the replacement lower A/T cooler hose and secure with clamps.
- 16. Install the replacement upper A/T cooler hose and secure with clamps.
- 17. Reinstall all other removed components by reversing the order of removal.
- 18. Restore the customer's radio presets as recorded in step 2.
- 19. Start the vehicle, check for possible transaxle leaks and correct fluid level.
