Reason for this recall Incorrect routing of the entrance step wires, may allow them to be pinched by the sharp edge of the door threshold, creating a ground connection that could activate the step to retract on its own. In the event that the step would retract on its own, personal injury may occur to anyone exiting the motorhome..

Recall Remedy Inspection of the step wiring for proper placement and when necessarily, rewiring of the step.

What we need you to do Please contact an authorized Dealer as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. The Recall Remedy is free of charge and will take approximately 30 minutes to complete.

If you had this repair completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
