AMENDED DEFECT INFORMATION REPORT (16V858)

This supplements Toyota's Amended Part 573 Report of June 29, 2017 concerning the rear sliding door issue on certain Toyota vehicles.

The description of Corrective Repair Action, Recall Schedule, and Distributor/Dealer Notification schedule are revised as noted below:

Description of Corrective Repair Action:

Toyota is implementing the remedy for this recall in two phases. Phase 1 involves the majority of vehicles involved in this recall. Phase 2 involves vehicles that were converted for side-entry wheelchair accessibility by an authorized Toyota equipment partner. For vehicles involved in Phase 1, all known owners of those vehicles will be notified by first class mail that the remedy is now available and to return their vehicles to a Toyota dealer. In these cases, the dealer will replace the existing junction block and the rear sliding door wire harnesses with newly designed ones. The dealer will also install two sub wire harnesses to connect the junction block to the two rear door wire harnesses. The remedy will be provided at no cost to the consumer. The remedy for Phase 1 is not applicable to vehicles in Phase 2; the remedy for vehicles in Phase 2 is still under development.

Recall Schedule:

Notifications to owners of the affected vehicles in Phase 1 will begin by the week of July 17, 2017. A copy of the draft owner notification letter will be submitted as soon as available.

Distributor/Dealer Notification Schedule:

Notifications to distributors/dealers will be sent during the week of July 10, 2017 to initiate the remedy for Phase 1 vehicles. Copies of dealer communications will be submitted as they are issued.
