Description of Defect:

Description of the Defect: Updated December 7, 2018: This submission is to inform the Agency of Ford's intent to implement the "Other" report category for removed vehicles in Quarterly Reporting as permitted in the Third Amendment to the Coordinated Remedy Order (ACRO3), paragraphs 45 through 49. As a condition of ACRO3, all affected vehicles will remain active, or "live," across Ford's data systems such that any search of "Other" removed VINs will return an open recall status. For this reason, the number of potential involved vehicles in this report will remain the same. However, for reference, initial counts of vehicles in the "Other" reporting category are indicated in the attached supplement. Note that these counts are current as of fourth calendar quarter of 2018. Future changes to overall Total Removed counts, including "Other" will be reflected in quarterly reporting.

> The passenger frontal airbag inflator could rupture if the vehicle is involved in a crash where the supplemental frontal airbags are designed to deploy. This defect report is in response to DIRs 17E-001, 17E-002, and 17E-003. Ford is not aware of any reports of accident or injury related to this condition.

Description of the Cause: The Agency has concluded that the rate at which propellant degradation my occur in non-desiccated ammonium nitrate based frontal airbag inflators varies based upon geographic factors of environmental heat and humidity. In light of the Agency's findings, NHTSA has concluded that at some point in the future all non-desiccated frontal Takata PSAN inflators will reach a threshold level of degradation that could result in the inflator becoming unreasonably dangerous.

Chronology:

On May 3, 2016, the Agency issued an Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order in EA15-001. The Agency has concluded that the rate at which propellant degradation may occur in non-desiccated frontal airbag inflators varies based upon geographic factors of environmental heat and humidity. In light of the Agency's findings, NHTSA has concluded that at some point in the future all non-desiccated frontal Takata PSAN inflators will reach a threshold level of degradation that could result in the inflator becoming unreasonably dangerous.

As directed in the May 3, 2016 Amendment, on January 3, 2017, Takata issued three Defect Information Reports (17E-001-Zone C), (17E-002-Zone A), and (17E-003-Zone B) in accordance with the terms specified in the May 3, 2016 Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order in EA15-001. Takata is not aware of any test ruptures in ballistic testing or confirmed field incidents of the subject non-desiccated ammonium nitrate inflators other than those already under recall. Out of an abundance of caution, Takata filed the DIRs in cooperation with NHTSA to promote public safety.

January 10, 2017, Ford's Field Review Committee reviewed the concern and approved a field action.

March 1, 2019: The manufacturer's identification code for this action was changed from 17S01 to 19S01.

August 9, 2024: This amendment updates the remedy to issue a Do Not Drive advisory for remaining unrepaired vehicles.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Owners will be notified by mail and instructed to take their vehicle to a Ford or Lincoln dealer to have their passenger frontal airbag inflator replaced. There will be no charge for this service.

> On August 9, 2024, to further urge owners to have their vehicle repaired for the subject safety recall, Ford is issuing a DO NOT DRIVE advisory for the vehicles involved in this recall that remain unrepaired. Re-notification owner letters will be mailed according to the provided recall schedule.

> Ford will forward a copy of the notification letter to dealers to the agency when available.
