Description of the Noncompliance : The tire information printed on the Federal Certification label and Tire Placard are incorrect. The information printed was for ST225/75R15 Load Range E tires when it should have been for ST225/75R15 Load Range D tires.

FMVSS 1 : 110 - Tire selection and rims

FMVSS 2 : 567 - Certification

Description of the Safety Risk : Per the information contained on the labels, an owner could overinflate their tires installed on the trailer. The Load Range D tires have a cold inflation pressure of 65 psi and the Load Range E tires have a cold inflation pressure of 80 psi.

Description of the Cause : The tire were being upgraded to Load Range E from Load Range D as a product improvement. The start of production date was not entered correctly resulting in incorrect labels.

Chronology :

- January 2, 2017 - Incorrect labels were printed and placed on the trailers.
- January, 16, 2017 - The incorrect labels were discovered in production during a routine quality audit.
- January 17, 2017 - The Airstream Safety Committee met and decided that a recall was appropriate for the mislabeled trailers.
- January 18-19, 2017 - The vehicle population was determined and all units onsite corrected.
- January 20, 2017 - 573 submitted to NHTSA.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : Corrected labels will be sent to affected customers and dealers for installation. This will be done at no cost to the owner.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : The tire information has been corrected from Load Range E to Load Range D.

Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production : The issue was corrected on January 17, 2017.
