Chronology:

Internal quality inspection in engine block manufacturing detected deviation from specification in September 2016 and in consequence banned all affected parts from production.

In mid November 2016, quality inspection reported to the vehicle plant in Mexico some additional affected engines had been delievered back in October 2016. Although production in Mexico was immediately blocked, some of these engines/vehicles had already left the factory.

During December 2016, most vehicles that had been allocated were returned to the factory, but it was detected, that a total of (3) three vehicles (two in the U.S. and one in Canada) had already been delivered to dealers and sold to customers.

On January 27, 2017 the matter was brought to Volkswagen's product safety committe and a determination of defect was made.
