The vehicles affected by this recall have incorrect tire placards that erroneously state the seating capacity as six occupants rather than seven occupants, with a combined

weight of 950 lbs. rather than 1,100 lbs.

#### **Description of Noncompliance:**

Description of the Some RU PHEV have a tire placard label with incorrect seating capacity and Noncompliance: calculated combined occupant and cargo weight ("calculated weight"). The

affected vehicles have a tire label showing six total passengers with 950 lbs. combined weight. The six total passengers are either displayed as one front and five rear, or two front and four rear. Vehicles not affected by this recall have a tire label showing seven total passengers (two front and five rear) with 1,100 lbs. combined weight. Per FMVSS 571.110 requirements, each vehicle placard shall show the vehicle capacity weight expressed as "The combined weight of occupants and cargo should never exceed XXX kilograms or XXX pounds"; and designated seated capacity (expressed in terms of total number

of occupants and number of occupants for each front and rear seat location).

label, it is understated from the actual vehicle certification. If vehicle owners relied on the incorrect tire placard label, there would be no risk to motor vehicle safety. The incorrect tire placard label may, however, cause customer confusion potentially leading to vehicle overloading resulting in a failed tire, which could cause a vehicle crash without warning.

#### **Chronology:**

- On May 09, 2017, the FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Vehicle Safety and Regulatory Compliance ("VSRC") organization received an email from FCA US Weight Engineering indicating that the tire placard on certain 2017 MY RU PHEV incorrectly states front row passenger seating capacity.
- On May 10, 2017, a cross-functional meeting was held to discuss the issue, consequence, and scope.
- On May 16, 2017, further discussion with the VSRC Label Management team was held for clarification of applicable regulations.
- On June 6, 2017, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary non-compliance safety recall of the affected vehicles.

#### **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: FCA US will conduct a voluntary non-compliance safety recall on all

affected vehicles to replace the tire placard label.

FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the

expense.
