June 7 – June 16, 2017 Honda launched an investigation, including a review of manufacturing processes, yard inspection of available vehicles, and the potential consequences of this misrouting. June 29, 2017 Honda made the determination that a defect related to motor vehicle safety exists and decided to conduct a safety recall.

As of June 29, 2017, Honda has not received any field reports, warranty claims, nor reports of fire or injuries related to this issue.
