Descriptive Information : Recall trailers have the Bright Way breakaway box #2305 with new circuit board charger installed as the breakaway kit. Trailers not recalled have a conventional charger that proven reliable over many years.

Description of the Defect : The breakaway junction box contains a push to test light that may remain lit at all times.

FMVSS 1 : NR

FMVSS 2 : NR

Description of the Safety Risk : If push to test light remains lit for a significant amount of time, there is a risk that the circuit board may fail causing the breakaway battery not to work as intended.

Description of the Cause : Push to test light on the breakaway battery kit remains lit.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : The push to test charge light will remain on.

Chronology :

July 10: Carry-On received 3 reports of the push to test light remaining on at all times. The company investigated the issue and identified the possible root cause as being a defect in the circuit board

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : Remove the circuit board and replace it with a previously used breakaway charger without a push to test light. Dealer has been sent recall and repair kits along with the trailer VIN's shipped to them. Purchasers of the trailers are being contacted by the dealers who will tell them how to have their trailer repaired by the dealer.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : Bright Way Group #2305 breakaway battery box

Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production : All manufacturing facilities were sent replacement battery chargers to retrofit all trailers in stock and in production. Carry-On suspended shipping of trailers until retrofit was completed. Future production will contain the retrofitted breakaway box.
