Important Safety Recall Notice: Far East and Innova Trailer Tires

Recall Overview Harbor Freight Tools (HFT) has concluded that certain Innova Ultra Runner and Far East brand trailer tires do not comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 119 and is conducting a recall. HFT is providing this notice to the Stores as required by Federal law.

The tires were produced under the Innova and Far East brands. The tires were sold individually and as part of a utility trailer kit.

Reason for Reason for Recall

Recall and Product Included

The tires may not meet the strength requirements under FMVSS 119 which could potentially increase the risk of tire failure and a crash.
