## **UPDATE:** <u>Takata Recalls</u> Front Passenger Air Bag Inflator Owner Notification

As we work through the Takata recall process, we will continue to mail owner notification and renotification letters to urge additional customers to schedule an appointment for the repair. This notification process is being prioritized in phases, based on parts supply, age of the inflator in the vehicle (oldest first), and geographic registration history of the vehicle.

At the end of this month, the next phase of these owner notification letters will be mailed for the following affected vehicles:

TKA16 & TKA17: 2010-2012 MY Legacy and Outback vehicles (approximately 32,000)

TKA16: 2003-2004 MY Legacy and Outback; 2003-2006 MY Baja vehicles (approximately 7,100)

Affected VIN lists will be distributed to each Zone Office.
