A revised Service Bulletin in support of Phases 1 and 2 of the SAFETY RECALL of the certain 2006-2012 GL1800-8A (Airbag type) motorcycles to replace the airbag module is posted on *iN*.

SERVICE BULLETIN [Service Bulletin GL1800 #24](#) has been revised to include expanded affected vehicle information, expanded warranty claim information, as well as expanded parts information.

AFFECTED UNITS Certain 2006-2012 GL1800-8A (Airbag type) motorcycles

Use *Unit Information* on *iN* to determine if this recall applies to a specific unit.

- Do not assume that a GL1800-8A motorcycle is affected by this recall. You must check *Unit Information* on *iN* for recall applicability before repairing any vehicle.

PARTS INFORMATION Make sure all parts personnel review [Parts Information Bulletin MPB 16071](#) before placing any orders for repair parts.

- Expanded remedy parts information: Affected model year 2012 vehicles will require a different remedy part than affected 2006-2010 vehicles.
  - P/N 06775-MCA-S80ZA will be available from mid-February 2017
- Redesigned airbag modules to repair affected motorcycles are available as a controlled part. An affected vehicle VIN will be required to order the airbag module kit.
- The recalled original equipment airbag module must be returned to Takata for analysis and safe disposal. For shipping instructions, refer to the Parts Information Bulletin.

Make sure all departments in your dealership are aware of this action.
