Subject: Safety Recall 69P6 - Takata Passenger Frontal Airbag Inflator (DIR2)

On March 15, 2018 interim repairs began for vehicles affected by Safety Recall 69P6. Refer to the campaign circular posted to Elsa and ServiceNet for additional information.

The first wave of owner notifications under this recall began on March 30, 2018. These notifications were to the non-Cabriolet owners. The Cabriolet owners will be notified as soon as parts become available.

Dealers must ensure that every affected inventory vehicle has this campaign completed before delivery to consumers.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
