	Background			
Issue	This Recall Campaign has been initiated because Daimler AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has decided that on certain GLE and GLS vehicles (166 platform) the bonding of the windshield might not meet the specifications. The windshield bonding may be insufficient and, as a result, the windshield may separate from the vehicle in a crash. As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 208, "Occupant Crash Protection" and number 212, "Windshield Mounting." If the windshield detaches in the event of a crash, the passenger frontal air bag may not be supported properly after it deploys, increasing the risk of injury.			
What We're Doing	MBUSA will coordinate and conduct a voluntary recall to replace the windshield on affected vehicles.

Replace Windshield

Daimler AG ('DAG'), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain GLE and GLS vehicles (166 platform) the bonding of the windshield might not meet current production specification. In the event of a crash, the windshield might separate from the vehicle body, subsequently reducing the restraining effect of the front passenger airbag, and increasing the risk of injury for the vehicle's front seat passenger. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will exchange the windshield on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- Please check VMI to determine if the vehicle is involved in the Campaign and if it has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

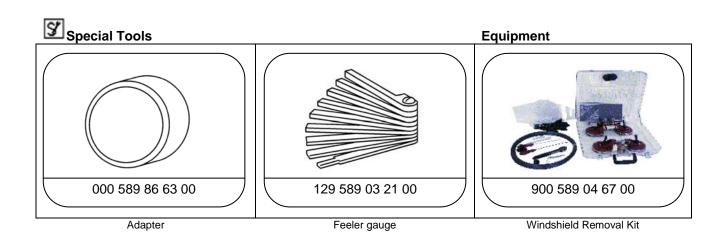
