Dear Heartland RV Valued Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Heartland RV (Heartland) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Heartland Cyclone & Road warrior Fifth Wheel travel trailers manufactured from August 22, 2016 to February 01, 2017. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you, however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason for
this recall***

On certain Cyclone & Road Warrior fifth wheel trailers manufactured with a Furrion Cook Top. The LP hose going to the cook top is angled down and is pressing against the top of the oven causing the LP hose to put excessive pressure on the hose fitting and gas valve. This could cause the hose or valve to develop an LP leak over time and could lead to an increased risk of injury and/or damage to property.

Instructions for the repair and a list of the affected coaches with their VIN #'s can be found on the warranty portal.
