## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 17V-208 / 16E-092

Dear IMT Vehicle Owner:

Ref: IMT Refuse trucks with Agility CNG system using Motion Industry hoses  
VIN:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IMT has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on your IMT Refuse Truck which was built with an Agility CNG system using Motion Industry hoses.

### **! I M P O R T A N T !**

- This recall repair will result in **no cost** to you.

#### **Why is a recall being conducted?**

IMT has identified that some Refuse trucks equipped with an Agility CNG system using Motion Industry CNG hoses may exhibit corrosion. The stainless steel braid reinforcement on Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses may be susceptible to premature corrosion due to a combination of the accumulation of road salt and the environment. If the corrosion progresses and remains undetected, the hose may leak in sufficient volumes as to create a risk of fire if an ignition source is present. In addition, a high pressure fuel leak may create a risk of damage to surrounding components and/or personal injury to adjacent personnel.

#### **What are we doing about the problem?**

Agility and its authorized representatives will inspect your vehicle to determine whether it is equipped with one of the defective hose assemblies. If so, Agility will replace the defective hose assembly free of charge (parts and labor). Replacement parts are currently available.

- If you detect a CNG fuel leak on your vehicle, the truck should not be operated until the fuel leak is corrected.

**What should you do?**

- Please call Agility Fuel Solutions at your earliest opportunity at (949) 267-7745 to schedule a service appointment. Please mention Recall No. 16E-092, the VIN of the vehicle as shown above in this letter and fitting types, hose size and length if possible.
- The repair should take less than 1 hour. However, because of scheduling needs, the vehicle may need to be available for a longer period. Agility will do its best to minimize the time that the vehicle needs to be available.
