Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2017-2018 Keystone Raptor Fifth Wheels. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall.

It has been decided the vehicles in this recall population may have been manufactured with tires that may come into contact with the outriggers. The tires and outriggers touching during travel may lead to an increased risk of loss of control and vehicle crash. The vehicles included in the recall are:
