Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2017 CR-V Rear Fuel Feed Pipe

On July 14, 2017, American Honda announced a **STOP SALE** and **Safety Recall** for certain 2017 CR-V vehicles that are at risk of a fuel leak that can lead to an engine stall or fire. Check VIN Status to determine which units in your inventory are affected.

Note: Failure to repair a vehicle subject to a recall or campaign may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits from the customer or anyone else harmed as a result of such failure.

Basic Concern

The connector between the fuel feed pipe and the fuel line may disconnect when the fuel line is pressurized. If the fuel line disconnects, it may result in a fuel leak, which can lead to an engine stall or fire, increasing the risk of an accident.

Campaign and Repair Information

Service bulletin 17-062 has been posted on the Service Information System (SIS).

Parts

AHM will allocate to dealers 1,700 parts this week. Additional allocations will be made the week of July 17, 2017. By July 25, 2017 we will have allocated enough parts to repair all dealer vehicles in stock.

Tools

No special or specific shop tools needed for the repair procedure in service bulletin 17-062.

Warranty

Customer Notification

American Honda expects to begin customer notification by mail late August.
