New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – T4808082017

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2017 (LD) Dodge Charger and 2017 (LA) Dodge Challenger vehicles equipped with a 6.2L Supercharged engine (Sales Code ESD).

Some of the above vehicles may experience engine oil cooler line separation at the crimped joining of the rubber hose to the aluminum tube. In the event of the line separation the driver may experience impaired visibility due to oil spray on the windshield, engine seizure, and potential risk of a fire due to the engine oil contacting a hot surface. The rapid loss of engine oil resulting in impaired visibility may result in a crash without a warning.

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the engine oil cooler lines.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2017
