TO: ALL MERCEDES-BENZ CENTERS

SUBJECT: Models 205, 213, and 253 Model Year 2017 Replace Electric Power Steering Rack

Daimler AG ('DAG'), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that in certain C-Class (205 platform), E-Class (213 platform) and GLC (253 platform) vehicles, the contacts inside the electric power steering control unit might not have been properly welded. If the pins completely lose contact, the electric power steering assist will deactivate, potentially increasing the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer, will replace the electric power steering rack on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- Please check VMI to determine if the vehicle is involved in the Campaign and if it has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

Approximately 4 vehicles are involved.
