IMPORTANT NOTICE TO DEALERS - FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION

Volkswagen has notified NHTSA and Transport Canada about the upcoming safety recall described in this letter.

CODE	94J9
AFFECTED VEHICLES	Certain 2018 MY Volkswagen Tiguan (Long Wheelbase) Check your daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in your inventory.
RECALL DESCRIPTION	The back-up lights may not be bright enough to meet federal regulatory requirements. (USA) FMVSS 108 / (Canada) CMVSS 108 - Lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment
CORRECTIVE ACTION	Replace back-up lights (inner tail light assembly). Repair information will be provided to dealers when parts and repair instructions become available to support this recall.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
