Subject: Advance Notice Safety Recall 70G6 – Door Speaker Trim

Audi has notified NHTSA and Transport Canada about the upcoming safety recall described in this letter.

CODE	70G6
AFFECTED VEHICLES	Certain 2017-2018 MY Audi A4, allroad and certain 2018 A5 Sportback vehicles. Check your daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in your inventory.
RECALL DESCRIPTION	The aluminum trim on the front and rear door speaker covers can come loose. Loosened trim may bend away from the speaker cover and could expose sharp edges. Injury (such as a cut or puncture) could occur if someone came into contact with one of these sharp edges. When replacement aluminum trim becomes available, new aluminum trim will be installed under a new Service Action free of charge. In the interim, if an owner requests removal of the affected speaker trim, dealers should do so at no cost to customers. Information on claiming trim removal for these cases will be provided shortly.
PRECAUTIONS	If trim has already bent away from a speaker cover, owners should contact their Audi dealer immediately to have the trim removed. Trim removal will be done free of charge. Additionally, if an owner requests removal of the affected speaker trim, dealers should do so at no cost to customers.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS
New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.
Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
