Subject: Revision to Safety Recall 70G6 - Door Speaker Trim

Certain 2017-2018 MY Audi A4 & allroad & Certain 2018 MY Audi A5 Sportback

On March 02, 2018, updated work instructions for Safety Recall 70G6 will be available in Elsa and ServiceNet.

- The revised work instructions will cover removal of the factory-installed speaker trim, and installation of new trim in affected vehicles.
- Owners of vehicles that did not have the speaker trim removed under an interim repair will be notified in March 2018.
- Owners of vehicles that have had the speaker trim removed under an interim repair
 will be notified at a later date (via a Service Action) to have new trim installed once
 sufficient parts stock becomes available.

Dealers must ensure that every affected inventory vehicle has this campaign completed <u>before</u> delivery to consumers.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

<u>New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

<u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
