



Revised New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – T84

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2018-model year (GA) Alfa Romeo Giulia and (GU) Alfa Romeo Stelvio vehicles.

Additional VINs have been identified as being involved in this campaign and are currently live and searchable. **Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.**

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with non-compatible oil in the brake system; using non-compatible oil can damage the system components and may decrease braking performance. This could cause a crash without warning.

SERVICE ACTION

The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 1st Quarter of 2018.
