



SAFETY RECALL NOTICE STOP SALE COMMUNICATION

To: All U.S. Maserati Dealers
Subject: Safety Recall 363 – 2018 Model Year Maserati Quattroporte vehicles, equipped with the V6 and V8 gasoline engine, as well as 2018 Model year Maserati Ghibli vehicles, equipped with V6 gasoline engine

Effective immediately, the vehicles listed on the attachment must not be delivered to customers. The subject vehicles are included in a safety recall related to a potential fuel leakage, at the quick connectors, and within the engine compartment and underfloor of vehicle connectors. This leakage is due to an excessive peeling of the plastic fuel line end during the preliminary phase before the fuel line quick connector is assembled onto the line. Potential other fuel leaks may be due to foreign particles being introduced during the connection process between the metal fuel line and plastic fuel line which causes scratches on the plastic fuel line. Consequences of the defect would indicate a potential for fuel to leak from the fuel line. Fuel vapors from fuel line weepage/leakage within the engine compartment may result in vehicle fire, which could cause injury to persons in or around the vehicle.

Vehicles in the recall will have the fuel line replaced. Maserati intends to notify owners on or before February 9, 2017 to schedule appointments to have their vehicles fixed.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied. Violation of this requirement by could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. You must correct all vehicles in your new vehicle inventory before delivery.
