Recall Campaign No. 17E-052: Dealer Accessory Turn Signals

Dear BMW Owner / Lessee:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. BMW AG has decided that certain dealer accessory turn signals (for Model Year 2006-2017 BMW R1200GS, 2007-2017 R1200GS Adventure, 2017 F700GS and F800GS, 2014-2017 F800GS Adventure, 2013-2017 F800GT, 2015-2016 F800R, 2015-2017 R1200R, 2016-2017 R1200RS, 2014-2016 S1000R, and Model Year 2010-2017 S1000RR motorcycles) fail to conform to FMVSS No. 108 (Lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment). Our records indicate that you are the owner of a potentially affected motorcycle.

Why are we contacting you?

We are pleased to inform you that we are ready to perform this recall. If you purchased dealer accessory turn signals for your motorcycle, please contact your authorized BMW Motorcycle dealer immediately to schedule an appointment. To locate your nearest BMW motorcycle dealer, visit www.bmwmotorcycles.com/dealers.

What could happen?

This Non-Compliance Recall involves the front and/or rear dealer accessory turn signals which do not conform to Federal requirements. As a result, affected motorcycles may be less noticeable to drivers of approaching vehicles which could increase the risk of a crash.

If you are not the only rider of this motorcycle, please advise all other riders of this important information.

What will BMW do?

The accessory turn signals will be replaced with ones which conform to Federal requirements. This will be performed **free of charge** by your authorized BMW motorcycle dealer, and will take approximately one hour.

What if the current motorcycle ownership information is incorrect?

You can update motorcycle ownership and contact information by completing the enclosed postage-paid card. If you are a motorcycle lessor, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee within ten days.
