## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NHTSA RECALL NO. 17V-071

Dear Olive Fire Department:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Midwest Fire has decided that a model year 2017 All-Poly Series vehicle has failed to conform to the requirements Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108 (Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment). This vehicle may contain a stop light switch that may not illuminate the brake lights when the brakes are applied. If the brakes lights do not illuminate when the brakes are pressed, other drivers may not know that the vehicle is slowing or stopping thereby increasing the risk of a crash.

A Peterbilt dealer will inspect and replace the affected brake light switch. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at [www.Peterbilt.com](http://www.Peterbilt.com). This repair should take approximately 0.5 hours Labor and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

Federal law requires any lessor who receives a notification of a determination of a safety-related defect or noncompliance pertaining to any leased motor vehicle shall send the notice to the lessee within 10 days.

If you are no longer owner of this vehicle, please provide us with any contact information so we may contact the new owner.

If you believe there is a failure to remedy this defect without charge and within a reasonable time, you may submit a written complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE, Washington, D.C. 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
