

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

This notice applies to your vehicle: **Schwarze Street Sweeper**

Dear **Schwarze Customer**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Schwarze Industries, Inc. has decided that certain A7 Tornado, A8 Twister, A9 Monsoon and M6 Avalanche sweepers fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 121 "Air Brake Systems".

! IMPORTANT !

- Your street sweeper is being recalled
- You should repair your affected sweeper immediately or contact your local Schwarze dealer immediately to schedule repairs to the affected components.

Why is a recall being conducted?

Schwarze industries, Inc. has determined that an incorrect fitting may be installed in your sweeper braking system. This fitting may cause brake tube damage and a subsequent air leakage in the parking brake system, resulting in uncommanded application of the brake system. This would cause the sweeper to stall without warning, which could result in a crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

Enclosed with this notice is a repair kit along with installation instructions. You may install this kit yourself to complete the needed repair or contact your local Schwarze dealer to perform the repair free of charge. The repair takes about 15 minutes to complete.

What should you do?

If you still have this vehicle, you should immediately perform the repair by using the provided parts kit and instructions or call your local Schwarze dealer to schedule your repair. If you are not sure who your Schwarze dealer is, call the information number listed below. If you choose to install the repair kit yourself, we ask you to sign, date, the affidavit indicating the repair has been completed, and return in the prepaid FedEx envelope. Schwarze will rely on the accuracy of your representation when it makes its quarterly reports to the Federal government about the recall completion rate.

What if you no longer own this sweeper?

Please contact your local Schwarze dealer, or call the number listed below and report that you no longer own this vehicle and report the identity of the new owner if known.


If you are the lessor of this vehicle,
