



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

This important safety recall notice applies to original equipment installed on your vehicle(s) with the following Vehicle Identification Number(s) ("VIN"):

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

ROUSH CleanTech, LLC ("Roush"), has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain ROUSH CleanTech liquid propane autogas fuel system converter kits that were installed on the vehicles identified above. According to our records, you are the owner of the above-referenced vehicles.

Under certain circumstances, the fuel control valve solenoid coils on certain LPG fuel control valve assemblies have exhibited over-current/ short to ground behavior, which resulted in high temperatures and damage to the non-conductive encapsulant material that housed the coil wire windings. If this occurs, the valve closes, stopping the flow of propane to the engine, which will cause the engine to shut off. If the engine shuts off while the vehicle is in motion, it could increase the risk of a crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO:

To remedy this problem, Roush will replace the defective fuel control valve solenoid coils at no cost to you.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

At your earliest convenience, please call National Fleet Services of Ohio at 440-930-5177 to obtain instructions on how to have your vehicle repaired. When you call, please be prepared to provide us with your name and the VIN of each of your vehicles that are covered by this Notification. We estimate that each repair will take approximately 30 minutes to complete.

If you no longer own one or more of the above-referenced vehicles, please call National Fleet Services of Ohio at 440-930-5177 and provide us with the name and address of the current owner(s) (if you know them) so we may contact them regarding this recall.

If you believe that National Fleet Services of Ohio has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge within a reasonable time, please contact us at 440-930-5177.
