IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: Safety Recall 17KWb – Neway ADZ Tridem Brake Lines

Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that certain 2013-2018 T800 and T880 vehicles with Neway ADZ Tridem rear suspension manufactured from 01/17/2012 through 04/05/2017 fail to conform to with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) No. 121, "Air Brake Systems." The brake control airline may be the incorrect size, resulting in an imbalance in the service brake application timing. An incorrectly sized airline may lengthen the distance needed to stop the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Oversize airlines may delay air brake release
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Dealers will install the proper size air lines and associated fittings
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your Kenworth Dealer to schedule an appointment for repair

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the air brake lines and associated fittings. This repair should take approximately **1.0 hour** depending on vehicle configuration and dealer scheduling, and will be performed at no charge to you. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
