Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that certain 2016 – 2017 Buick Envision vehicles may not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 202a, "Head Restraints." As a result, GM is conducting a recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM safety recall 17239
- Schedule an appointment with your GM dealer.
This service will be performed for you at **no charge**.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

GM's Universal Tablet Holder accessory, if incorrectly installed on front seat head restraints in Buick Envision vehicles, may prevent the head restraint posts from fully engaging in the seat back. A head restraint that is not fully engaged in the seat back could loosen and dislodge, or inadvertently move to an undesired height which may provide insufficient head and neck support, increasing an occupant's risk of injury in a crash.

What will we do?

Your GM dealer will Buick dealer will inspect the head restraints and tablet holders for correct installation and reinstall if necessary. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual inspection and service correction time of approximately 25 minutes.

What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
