IMPORTANT RECALL

RECALL CAMPAIGN 17V-512

Incorrect GVWR on Federal Placard

This letter is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Tiny Idahomes LLC/ Rugged Mountain Custom RV has decided that a noncompliance exists in certain 2014-2017 Tiny Idahomes Clear Creek, Cascade, Sejour, Carpathian, Cargo Trailers; 2016 Tiny Idahomes Zamora Vardo; 2017 Tiny Idahomes Yala Peak, and Grand Teton; and 2017 Rugged Mountain Custom RVs models Clear Creek, Drive Stream, Chinook Peak, Mt. Hood, Castle Peak, and Lincoln Peak recreational vehicles. The Federal Placard on these vehicles may indicate an incorrect Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR). As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 567, "Certification."

What is the Defect/noncompliance?

The Federal Placards for affected vehicles indicate that the vehicles have the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) wrong calculation as follows:

On 2-6K axles bumper pull units: GVWR placard indicates 12,000 LBS whereas the GVWR should indicate 13,018 LBS; **On 2-6k axles goosenecks:** GVWR placard indicates 12,000 LBS whereas the GVWR should indicate 14,150 LBS; **On 2-7k axles bumper pull units:** GVWR placard indicates 14,000 LBS whereas the GVWR should indicate 16,100 LBS; **On 2-7k axles goosenecks:** GVWR placard indicates 14,000 LBS whereas the GVWR should indicate 17,500 LBS

Why is this recall being conducted?

This recall is being conducted to provide you with accurate information regarding GVWR for your trailer.

Evaluation of the risk to the vehicle and operator(s) related to the recall

A label with an incorrect GVWR can cause confusion to the user and improper loading of the vehicle, possibly increasing the risk of a crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

Tiny Idahomes/Rugged Mountain Custom RV will mail corrected labels. Owners can affix the corrected label themselves or, if they wish, they can contact their dealer to have the Federal Placard replaced, free of charge.

What should you do?

Verify that the VIN number on the new placard matches the VIN number on the labels you have currently on your trailer. Place the new labels directly over the old labels, which will be located on the trailer frame. Cargo weight label (yellow label) is placed by the main door and the federal certification placard is placed on the trailer frame, located on the front left neck of the trailer.

Please make sure to wash and dry the area before applying new labels.
