This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Cruiser RV (Cruiser) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Cruiser travel trailers manufactured from our Idaho plant between April, 3 2017 and July, 19 2017. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you, however your continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason for  
this T.S.B***

On certain Cruiser Travel trailers manufactured in our Idaho production Facilities the Axles were installed backwards. This issue it can cause reduced braking, brake squeal and chatter and in some cases the brakes can temporarily lock up. The correction for this is to flip the axles so that the axles are in the correct orientation for travel.

***What we  
will do***

Cruiser will have an authorized dealer or repair center flip the axles to the correct orientation for travel. This will be corrected at no expense to you, the owner. This repair should take approximately 3hrs to complete.

***What we need  
you to do***

At your earliest convenience, Please contact your local dealer to set up an appointment to have this inspected and if needed corrected immediately, this service will be performed free of charge. You will need the following information for the phone call:

- VIN of your travel trailer
- Name, Address, and Phone Number

If you have questions concerning this recall or if you need any assistance please contact the **Warranty/Service Department** by phone at 1-574-206-7920. If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Cruiser by contacting the **Cruiser Warranty/Service Department**.
