

NHTSA Recall No.: 17V-602

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your trailer VIN: xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. C&M Trailers has decided that certain C&M trailers fail to conform with the portion of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) §571.108 that states that the side rear marker lamp on trailers wider than 80 inches needs to be located between 15 and 60 inches from the ground on the side of your trailer at the rear of the trailer. Motorist may not be able to identify the correct length of a trailer, increasing the risk of a crash.

Why is recall being conducted?

This recall is being conducted to inform you of the noncompliance and to provide you information on where and how to have the noncompliance remedied to bring your trailer into compliance with the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 108 requirement.

What are we doing about the problem?

We are providing equipment and instructions to dealers so that when you take your trailer in they will be able to place the required marker lamp in a compliant location on your trailer, free of charge, bringing your trailer into compliance the requirement of FMVSS 108.

What should you do?

Contact the dealer you bought your trailer from and schedule a time to bring the trailer in for the remedy. If you prefer you can contact C&M directly to arrange to have the remedy completed at their location.
