IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 17512 NHTSA RECALL NO. 17V-659

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2017 CE and 2016 and 2017 RE school bus models built 17 December 2015 thru 22 January 2016 with IMMI 39 inch BTI 3-point seats fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 210, "Seat Belt Assembly Anchorages.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Certain IMMI school bus seat assemblies equipped with 3-point lap and shoulder belts do not satisfy the requirements of FMVSS 210. There is a potential that when under a sufficient load, the buckle mount rod may fracture.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

A seat belt assembly that does not conform to all the requirements of FMVSS 210 may not protect the occupant sufficiently in the event of a crash resulting in possible injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve replacement of the buckle mount rod. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 45 minutes to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

DECEMBER 2017

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at http://www.icbus.com.

if you have already paid for repairs that corrected the noncompliance, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE
