IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL**

**This Notice Applies to Your Recreational Vehicle VIN  
NHTSA Recall Campaign # 17V-696**

***Our records show that the Recall Remedy has not been completed on this unit. Please contact an authorized Dealer to set an appointment as soon as possible. If the Recall Remedy was performed, please complete the Reply form on the back of this letter and return to Jayco Corp. Compliance, so we can update our records.***

Dear Valued Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco has decided that certain 2016- 2018 Jay Flight SLX Travel Trailers manufactured July 17, 2015 through August 31, 2017 at the Idaho production facility and January 14, 2016 through August 31, 2017 at the Indiana production facility have incorrect wiring from the battery to the 35amp converter.

The electrical circuit from the battery to converter does not have overcurrent protection. If a short-circuit would occur, the unprotected circuit could overheat resulting in a fire, increasing the risk of injury and /or damage to property.

The Recall Remedy is the installation of appropriate circuit protection. The remedy will take approximately half an hour and will be at no cost to you. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within **ten days**.

If you take your recreational vehicle to your dealer on the agreed service date and the dealer does not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, please contact our Customer Service Department at 800-283-8267. If after contacting your dealer and Customer Service you are not able to have the safety defect remedied without charge and/or within a reasonable time, you may wish to submit a written complaint to the Administrator, national Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE., Washington, DC 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
