This Notice Applies To Your Vehicle, Vehicle Identification Number:

Dear Maserati Customer:

This notification is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Maserati S.p.A. and Maserati North America, Inc., have decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2018 Model Year Maserati Quattroporte vehicles, equipped with the V6 and V8 gasoline engine, as well as 2018 Model Year Maserati Ghibli vehicles, equipped with V6 gasoline engine.

Maserati S.p.A. has decided that the your vehicle may experience a fuel leakage. The raw material (coated straight metal tube) was received with bubbles on the external coating. During the end-forming operation, a bubble on the pipe end may have been scratched which resulted in an irregular chip that, during the assembly operation, may damage the inner plastic layer and could allow fuel to leak from the finished connection. Fuel vapors from the fuel line leakage, in the underbody of the vehicle, increases the risk of a vehicle fire, which could cause injury to persons in or around the vehicle.

Your Maserati Dealer will install a new fuel delivery line kit onto the affected vehicles, free of charge. Since your vehicle is among those that may be affected by the above condition, we ask you to contact any Authorized Maserati Dealer in order to arrange for this recall action to be performed to your automobile. The remedy will take approximately 2.5 hours to complete. Please prepare to leave your vehicle with the dealership to allow the dealer to complete your repairs. **By the time you receive this recall notification letter, the Authorized Maserati Dealers will have been supplied with the necessary instructions and components to perform the recall.**

Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten working days. If you no longer own this vehicle or your address has changed, **please complete the enclosed prepaid yellow card and return it to Maserati North America, Inc.**
