



**Important Safety Recall: NHTSA Campaign # 17V-842**

This notice applies to your Hyundai Translead Trailers on BOM# 30012400, 30012409, 30012410, 30012431, 30012434, 30012481 and 30012595. VIN list attached.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Meritor has decided that the brake caliper bolts on these trailers equipped with MPA/MTA suspensions and Meritor EX225 brakes may not have been properly torqued which can allow the caliper to detach from the mounting flange.

**Important!**

- Your trailer falls within the recall population
- You should avoid use and immediately schedule an appointment with Hyundai Translead to have your unit inspected and properly torqued.

<b>Why is a recall being conducted?</b>	Trailer Axles & MPA/MTA Suspensions found to have caliper bolts that did not meet torque specifications. The suspect axles and suspensions were assembled at the Meritor Frankfort site between January 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2017 and August 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2017. If the caliper bolts are improperly torqued and the caliper detaches from the mounting flange, a loss of braking ability would occur, increasing the risk of a crash.
<b>What are we doing about the problem?</b>	It is recommended that all affected vehicles suspend operation and be set up for immediate wheel end repair to the standards of the maintenance manual for greased wheel end. Dealers will inspect the bolts, replacing any loose or missing ones, free of charge.
<b>What should you do?</b>	Contact Hyundai Translead Warranty Department at <a href="mailto:warranty@translead.com">warranty@translead.com</a> or 800-251-0871 as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. Make sure to reference NHTSA Campaign Number: <b>17V-842</b> and provide the full VIN number.
