

## Fuel Line Replacement - Chassis (Cargo/Passenger Van)

## Removal Procedure




- 1. Remove the engine cover. Refer to Engine Cover Replacement. Disconnect the negative battery cable. Refer to **Battery Negative Cable Disconnection and Connection**.
- 2. Relieve the fuel system pressure. Refer to Fuel Pressure Relief.
- 3. Disconnect the fuel feed and evaporative emission (EVAP) pipes from the engine compartment fuel pipes.
- 4. Disconnect the chassis wiring harness electrical connector (1) from the fuel pressure sensor (2).
- 5. Remove the chassis wiring harness clip (3) from the fuel pipe.




- 6. Remove the fuel pipes from the bellhousing stud retainer clip.
- 7. Raise the vehicle. Refer to Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle.
- 8. Disconnect the fuel feed pipe at the fuel tank.
- 9. Disconnect the chassis EVAP pipe from the fuel tank.
- 10. Remove the fuel pipe retaining clips. Note the location of the retaining clips for installation.
- 11. Remove the fuel feed and EVAP pipes.

## **Installation Procedure**



- 1. Position the fuel feed and EVAP pipes in the vehicle.
- Caution: Refer to <u>Fastener Caution</u>.

  2. Install the fuel pipe retaining clips and tighten the clips to **12N·m** (**106 lb in**).
- 3. Connect the chassis EVAP pipe to the fuel tank EVAP pipe.
- 4. Connect the fuel feed pipe to the fuel tank pipe.



- 5. Connect the chassis wiring harness electrical connector (1) to the fuel pressure sensor (2).
- 6. Install the chassis wiring harness clip (3) to the fuel pipe.
- 7. Lower the vehicle.
- 8. Install the fuel feed and EVAP pipes to the engine compartment fuel pipes.
- 9. Install the fuel pipes to the retainer clip and tighten the nut to 28 N·m (21 lb ft).
- 10. Tighten the fuel filler cap.
- 11. Connect the negative battery cable. Battery Negative Cable Disconnection and Connection.
- 12. Inspect for leaks:
- 12.1. Turn ON the ignition for 2 seconds.
- 12.2. Turn OFF the ignition for 10 seconds.
- 12.3. Turn ON the ignition.
- 12.4. Inspect for fuel leaks.
- 13. Install the engine cover. Refer to Engine Cover Replacement.
