Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model 567 and 579 vehicles manufactured between May 16, 2016 and January 23, 2017 may have been built with a defective fuel tee fitting that leaks. During the manufacturing process the mold temperature was too low and as the material flowed into the mold the knit line could become porous allowing fuel to leak from the tee.

Fuel leakage in the presence of an ignition source could result in a fire.

<i>The problem is...</i>	A defective fuel tee
<i>Correction...</i>	Replace the fuel tee fitting free of charge
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately 1.0 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


