17V-605 OC3, 17V-676 Blower Motor, 17V-683 PCV Valve Heater**

Please read this important recall update, and share with all relevant personnel in your Parts and Service Departments.

Dear Colleagues,

I want to provide you with an update on our 3 “big” recalls from last year: 17V-605, 17V-676, and 17V-683. We have great news: customer mailings are starting; the chart below provides more detail on number of mailings and timing. Parts supply will continue to be monitored, so be sure to maximize your Fair Share Allocation allotment and ensure proper customer communication.

Please note: Many of the vehicles have overlapping recalls, which are outlined below.

** Since we have to notify customers for a recent recall 18V-314 Battery Cable by July 2018, we will also use the same vehicles as our first mailing for 17V-676.

Remedy Status:

- “Remedy Not Available”: We ask that you do not do any outreach, but please **do not turn away** any customers without checking **your parts inventory**. If you have available parts that are not assigned to another VIN, please repair the vehicle.
- “Remedy Available”: These are vehicles that are either in your inventory or customer letter has been mailed. You can actively do outreach for these vehicles.
- Schedule appointments based on your weekly Fair Share Allocation (FSA). Your allotment may change weekly; decrease or increase, based on supply and mailings.
- Your FSA allotment factors in claim data, so please submit your claims as quickly as possible.
