Description of Defect :

Description of the Defect : It has been decided the vehicles in this recall population may have been manufactured with Sterling Sport tires provided by Lionshead Specialty Tire and Wheel (Lionshead) rated for 1760 lbs. instead of tires rated for 2040 lbs. These insufficient load range tires were inadvertently mixed in with the correct load range tires by Lionshead.

Description of the Safety Risk : An overloaded tire leads to an increased risk of tire failure, property damage and/or vehicle crash.

Description of the Cause : Wrong tires supplied were ST205/75R14C instead of ST205/75R14D.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : Load range on the tire does not match load range on the unit's federal certification label.

January 22, 2018 – Production noted the installed tires rating did not match the unit configuration.
January 31, 2018 – Investigation concluded and determined the tires would need to be inspected and replaced if incorrect.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : The remedy is to replace the tires with the correct ones supplied by Keystone.
How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : The replacement tires are rated for the unit GAWR.
Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production : Units were quarantined, inspected then repaired as indicated by inspection.
