Description of the Defect: Our vendor, Lippert Componants, Inc. ("LPI") has decided that a defect which

relates to motor vehicle safety exists in vehicles equipped with certain LCI Power Tounge Jack (the "Smart Jack") for installation and use on towable

recreational vehicles.

Description of the Safety Risk: There is potential of a structural fracture of the top portion of the electronic

tongue jack, i.e. "Lippert SMART Jack", which may allow water intrusion and unintended movement of the SMART Jack. If this occurs the tongue jack can

automatically retract or extend causing an increased safety risk.

Description of the Cause: Touch pad or button screen could crack or delaminate which could result in

water intrusion to the electronics.

On or about January, 2018 our vendor Lippert Components, Inc. notified Lance Camper Mfg. Corp of their safety recall campaign# 17E-074. Lance then conducted an internal audit to determine the dealer and customer units affected. It was determined that approximately 2054 units have the Lance option# 415, and therefore a safety defect, leading to Lance to the noncompliance decision.

#### **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: Lippert Components, Inc. ("LCI") will replace the component with an

updated version which has the proper potting protection to ensure water intrusion will not cause the component to latch in any certain direction if the top of the jack becomes damaged. Lippert Components, Inc. will

supply the replacement component and reimburse all costs.
