vehicle which may cause the safety chains to not be able to support the tow

vehicle.

Description of the Safety Risk: In the event of a trailer becoming uncoupled from the tow vehicle, if the

safety chains fail, the trailer may separate, increasing the risk of a crash.

Description of the Cause: There was a miscalculation of the GVWR at the pre-production stage which led

to an incorrect safety chain rating being requested between Forest River and the frame supplier. Once the vehicles went into production, the accuracy of the

GVWR and safety chain rating was not confirmed.

Chronology:

During a routine internal Corporate Quality Control Inspection of the XLR ToyHauler plant's manufacturing processes, on February 15, 2018, the in-house auditor discovered a possible issue involving under-rated safety chains installed on specific models. The same day, Forest River's XLR ToyHauler division contacted Forest River's Office of Corporate Compliance ("OCC") and an investigation into the issue was initiated. The manufacturing plant contacted multiple dealerships to inspect the safety chains. The investigation revealed the affected models had been manufactured with the under-rated chains. This information was provided to Forest River's Office of Corporate Compliance on February 19, 2018.

Forest River reviewed internal data and found no warranty claims or customer complaints potentially related to this issue.

On February 23, 2018, Forest River's Corporate Committee decided to conduct a recall.
