•	retainer. In production, the brake switch retaining tab may not have been fully secured into the steel brake pedal assembly bracket. An unsecured tab could allow the switch and retainer to detach from the bracket.

Description of the Safety Risk :	If the switch and retainer detach from the bracket, the brake lights will illuminate whether or not brake pedal is depressed, the shift interlock will not operate and the accelerator pedal input will be disabled. The vehicle may lose motive power, increasing the risk of a crash.
Description of the Cause :	The defect arose from the improper installation of the nylon retainer clip.

Chronology:

Production of the subject Model Year 2018/2019 vehicles began in Japan on October 28, 2017. The 2018/2019

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Model Year vehicles are equipped with a new brake switch part for ease of assembly. The U.S. Isuzu port personnel first identified a problem with the brake switch on two vehicles on February 20, 2018. Isuzu initiated an investigation, and on March 8 enhanced the production process in Japan to ensure that the retainer is properly seated. On March 12, 2018, Isuzu quarantined vehicles at the port while continuing to investigate. On April 3, 2018, Isuzu informed NHTSA that the company intended to make a formal defect determination and to conduct a safety recall. Per discussion with the agency, a Stop Sale was provided to dealers on April 4, 2018, informing the dealers not to sell the affected vehicles in their inventory, if any; attempts to contact the 16 specific end users with affected vehicles have also been initiated. Isuzu made a formal defect determination on April 13, 2018. There have been no accidents or injuries associated with this issue.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program :	Dealers will be instructed to inspect the retainer to ensure that it is properly seated. If it is not, dealers will be instructed as to how to properly re-seat the retainer clip and/or determine that it cannot be properly re- seated. If the clip cannot be properly re-seated, dealers will install a replacement retainer clip.

Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production :	Assembly process reviewed and added verification check of retainer clip on March 8, 2018.

Description of Recall Schedule :	Per discussion with NHTSA, Isuzu contacted dealers after April 3, 2018 and also attempted to contact end users with affected vehicles. Dealers were informed to stop sale until inspection and any necessary remedy could be conducted. Formal dealer and customer notification will follow the filing of this report.
