Noncompliance: Homes manufactured by Gulf Stream Coach, Inc. ("GulfStream") during the time

period identified above, the Intermediate side marker lamps may not be installed in accordance with the Federal Regulation FMVSS Standard No. 108

requirements.

FMVSS 1: 108 - Lamps, reflective devices, and assoc. Equipment

FMVSS 2: NR

Description of the Safety Risk: Failure to provide adequate illumination and enhancing the conspicuity of the

motor homes on public roads so that their presence is perceived and understood in both daylight and in darkness or other conditions of reduced visibility may lead to unsafe identity of the motor vehicle, which could increase the risk of a crash causing injury and/or damage to property.

Description of the Cause: Failure to understand and/or confirm the maximum allowable distance

allowed between side marker lights was an oversight in our manufacturing processes.

During the review of FMVSS safety standards, the discovery of the omission of the intermediate side marker lamps was identified. The review of the FMVSS 108 Standard for overall length requirements confirmed the apparent oversight.

#### **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: All motor homes within the immediate control of "GulfStream" have been repaired prior to releasing for shipment to the respective selling dealerships. All identified motor homes will have materials and installation instructions provided free of charge to the selling dealer or repair facility of the owner's preference for installation of these intermediate side marker lamps. Instructions for the proper installation and location of the intermediate side marker lamps will be provided to all dealers/ owners of record owning the models identified which are the subjects of this recall. The installation of the side marker lamps and will be installed free of charge.

from Recalled Component:

How Remedy Component Differs This recall is based on the omission of the intermediate side marker lamps on Conquest and B Touring Cruiser models identified above where as the distance between the front and rear side marker lamps exceeded the allowable distance as noted in the FMVSS 108 standard.

Identify How/When Recall Condition Research of our manufacturing records with confirmation that the was Corrected in Production: intermediate side marker lamps had been omitted on certain Conquest Class "C" motor homes and B Touring Cruiser Class "C" motor homes which exceeded the FMVSS 108 standard requirements of (30) thirty feet. Subsequent identity of the suspect models has been completed and corrective actions implemented to correct the oversight.
