Description of the Defect: Daimler AG ("DAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has

determined that on certain E-Class cabriolet vehicles (238 platform) the ISOFIX console for child seats, might not have been mounted according to current

production specification.

Description of the Safety Risk: The child seat can still be coupled to the ISOFIX brackets. In case of a crash

the ISOFIX console might partially detach from the car body. Thus the risk of

injury for a child in a child seat might be increased.

Description of the Cause: Due to a deviation in the production process, the ISOFIX console might have

been mounted outside current specifications.

Chronology:

In November 2017, plant quality Management discovered and reported deviations in the mounting of the ISOFIX consoles.

In December 2017 and January 2018, DAG analyzed samples of the affected ISOFIX consoles for strength and durability.

In February 2018, these analyses indicated a potential effect on the fixing of the ISOFIX console to the car body. Further analyses were initiated to identify potential effects on the child seat fastening.

In May 2018, these analyses indicated that in the event of a crash the ISOFIX console could detach from the car body.

In June 2018, the range of potentially affected vehicles was determined according to production records.

In July 2018, DAG determined that a potential safety risk cannot be excluded.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: As a precautionary measure an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will

check the ISOFIX console on the affected vehicles and replace it, if necessary. Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 577.11(e), MBUSA does not plan to provide notice about pre-notice reimbursement to owners since all involved vehicles remain covered under the new vehicle warranty.
