During the investigation of a related non-compliance recall, manufacturer's identification code 7F7-P2S8D-12, it was discovered that 10mm tube nut fittings were used where 10mm banjo fittings were specified. This followed the October 25, 2018 compliance testing for the left / right current split service brake system. This issue was discussed with the Review Board on 12/18/2018, who escalated this to the PCM Group. The PCM Group met on 12/20/2018 and decided to escalate this as a recall candidate. Senior Management approved the recall on 12/21/2018.
