



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – U09

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2017 model year (RT) Dodge Caravan and (JK) Jeep® Wrangler vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.
Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicle's brake switches may malfunction identified by a Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) illumination, an audible chime, and the brake lights will be illuminated. A malfunctioning brake switch could allow the vehicle to be shifted out of PARK without the brake pedal being depressed, and could cause the rear brake lamps to be continuously illuminated. Being able to shift a vehicle out of PARK when the brake pedal is not depressed (and the ignition is in the RUN mode) and/or having the rear brake lamps continuously illuminated, can cause a vehicle to crash without prior warning.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the brake switch. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 1st Quarter of 2018.
