AFFECTED VEHICLES

2017-2018	Taurus	Chicago	July 31, 2017 through February 13, 2018

Affected vehicles are identified in OASIS and FSA VIN Lists.

NOTE: Approximately 1,950 vehicles are affected by this recall.

REASON FOR THIS COMPLIANCE RECALL

All of the affected vehicles may not conform to the requirements specified by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 114, Theft Protection and Rollaway Prevention. The vehicles were built with an incorrect transmission selector lever that allows the ignition key to be removed in any gear position. This could increase the risk of accidental rollaway of the vehicle.

SERVICE ACTION

DO NOT DEMONSTRATE OR DELIVER any new in-stock vehicles involved in this compliance recall. A complete Dealer Bulletin will be provided to dealers in mid-April 2018, when it is anticipated that parts ordering information and repair instructions will be available to support this compliance recall.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Owners of record will be notified via first-class mail after repair instructions and parts ordering information have been provided to dealers.

PLEASE NOTE:

Federal law requires dealers to complete this recall service before a new vehicle is delivered to the buyer or lessee. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Correct all vehicles in your new vehicle inventory prior to delivery.
